

The Executive Order by David Fisher (FIC FISHER D) When a series of coordinated terrorist attacks rock the United States, a reporter and war veteran discovers that the attacks might be coming from somewhere close to home.

Basil's War by Stephen Hunter (FIC HUNTER S) A British agent goes behind enemy lines to search for a religious text that might hold the key to ending the second World War.

Never by Ken Follett (FIC FOLLET K) A shrinking oasis in the Sahara Desert, a stolen US Army drone, an uninhabited Japanese island, and one country's secret stash of deadly chemical poisons all play roles in a relentlessly escalating crisis.

The Devil's Hand by Jack Carr (FIC CARR J) A PhD student has gained access to a bioweapon thought to be confined to a classified military laboratory as tensions grow on the other side of the globe—marking the United States as a target.

Scorpion by Christian Cantrell (FIC CANTRE C) An intelligence analyst for the CIA latest assignment involves a series of bizarre, international assassinations where victims are found with numeric codes tattooed, burned, or carved into their flesh.

The Island by Ben Coes (FIC COES B) CIA operative Dewey Andreas is America's last line of defense when terrorists take over Manhattan, targeting the U.N. and the President himself.

Damascus Station by David McCloskey (FIC MCCLOS D) A cat-and-mouse chase for a killer leads to a trail of high-profile assassinations and the discovery of a dark secret at the heart of the Syrian regime.

Sea Hawke by Ted Bell (FIC BELL T) After saving the kidnapped heir to the British throne, gentleman spy and MI6 legend Alex Hawke is due for some downtime... But what he hoped to be a pleasant around-the-world journey with his son turns out to be a brutal fight against terror.

Sleeping Bear by Connor Sullivan (FIC SULLIV C)
An Army veteran who goes missing in Alaska finds herself in a Russian prison, a predicament that may be connected to her father's secretive past.

The Eagle's Claw: A Novel of the Battle of Midway by Jeff Shaara (FIC SHAARA J) Recounts the Battle of Midway, sharing the stories of all ranks and the unique sacrifices each man is compelled to bravely make.

Tom Clancy's Chain of Command by Marc Cameron (FIC CLANCY T) To implement his most ambitious plan of all, a ruthless billionaire must get President Jack Ryan out of the way and assembles the most ruthless mercenaries alive to kidnap the First Lady.

Clive Cussler's The Devil's Sea by Dirk Cussler (FIC CUSSLER C) In 1959 Tibet, an important Buddhist artifact was seemingly lost to history during the Communist takeover. But when Dirk Pitt discovers a plane crash more than sixty years alter, new clues emerge to its existence.

Legacy of War by Wilbur Smith with David Churchill (FIC SMITH W) A Nazi supporter is determined to regain power in Germany and a dangerous game of cat-and-mouse develops.

The Kaiser's Web by Steve Berry (FIC BERRY S) A secret dossier from a World War II-era Soviet spy comes to light containing information that, could forever alter the political landscape of Europe and rewrite history.

Arctic Sea by David Poyer (FIC POYER D)
An admiral struggles to set up a US Navy base in Alaska in the midst of Russian tension in an imagining of the aftermath of WWII.

Steel Fear by Brandon Webb and John David Mann (FIC WEBB B) A Navy SEAL endeavors to hunt down a stealthy killer on an aircraft carrier.

Vince Flynn's Enemy at the Gates by Kyle Mills (FIC FLYNN V) A CIA agent must protect a trillionaire while using him as bait to uncover a traitor who has been searching for sensitive information.

Arctic Storm Rising by Dale Brown (FIC BROWN D) Exiled to guard a remote radar post along Alaska's Arctic Frontier, an intelligence officer is ordered to find a missing stealth bomber to prevent a potential nuclear holocaust.

Chasing the Lion by A. J. Tata (FIC TATA A)
A terrorist group plans to unleash a biochemical weapon on the Inauguration Day of America's first female president.

Relentless by Mark Greaney (FIC GREANE M)
Intelligence operatives around the world are disappearing, and when one missing agent reappears—it isn't for long, thanks to a team of assassins.

Deep Strike by Rick Campbell (FIC CAMPBE R)
A former special forces operative attacks a convoy leaving the U.N. headquarters in New York and plans another attack that will be more devastating than 9/11.

The Chaos Kind by Barry Eisler (FIC EISLER B)
An assistant US Attorney is determined to put one of America's most powerful financiers in prison forever for his crimes against children... but he has videos implicating some of the most powerful members of the US national security state.

W.E.B. Griffin's Rogue Asset by Brian Andrews and Jeffrey Wilson (FIC GRIFFI W)
The secretary of state has been kidnapped by Islamic extremists and his only hope for survival is a reconstituted Presidential Agent team.

Left for Dead by Sean Parnell (FIC PARNEL S) Special Operative Eric Steele battles a renegade group of bioterrorists armed with a devastating virus.

Black Ice by Brad Thor (FIC THOR B) A CIA agent's vacation sours when a man he thought he killed years ago makes a reappearance that could be disastrous for him and the United States.

American Traitor by Brad Taylor (FIC TAYLOR B)
Pike Logan is on the desperate hunt for a man who is about to betray his country--and ignite a horrific new world war.

2034: A Novel of the Next World War by Elliot Ackerman and James Stavridis (FIC ACKERM E)
This geopolitical thriller that imagines a naval clash between the US and China in the South China Sea in 2034—and the path from there to a nightmarish global conflagration.

Robert Ludlum's The Treadstone Exile by Joshua Hood (FIC LUDLUM R) Former Treadstone Operative Adam Hayes finds himself at the center of a web of warring factions and high-level secrets .

Shadow Target by David Ricciardi (FIC RICCIA D)
When a CIA agent's small plane crashes in the Alps, he is the only survivor. What seems to be a rescue helicopter soon arrives, but the men inside have no intention of saving anyone.

In the Company of Killers by Bryan Christy (FIC CHRIST B) An investigative reporter leading a double life as a CIA spy, discovers that he has been weaponized in a global game of espionage.

Red Widow by Alma Katsu (FIC KATSU A) Two CIA agents become entwined in a threat to the Russia Division—one that's coming from inside the agency.

Trial by Fire by P. T. Deutermann (FIC DEUTER P)
A novelization of a Japanese attack on a fleet of aircraft carriers in WWII and how the sailors of the USS Franklin saved their ship after three days of battling flames.
