1. Talk, Sing, Read, Write, and Play!

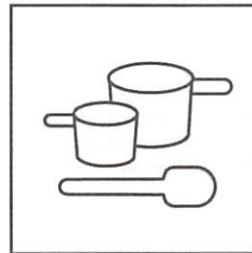
Complete and then color 5 of these activities with your child.



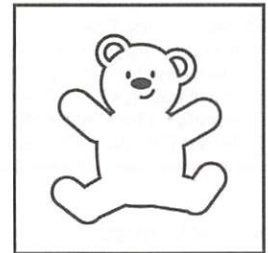
Register for the 1000 Books program or continue reading to reach your goal of 1000 Books.



Paint outdoor (for example, the sidewalk) surfaces using water and a child sized paintbrush.



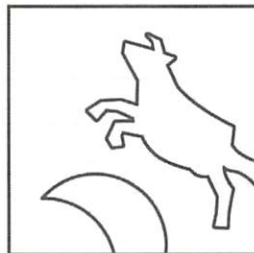
Use measuring cups and spoons for scooping and stirring water or sand.



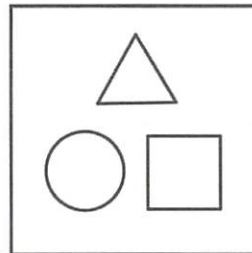
Tell a story using puppets or stuffed animals.



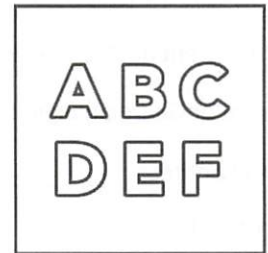
Count fingers, toes, eyes and ears.



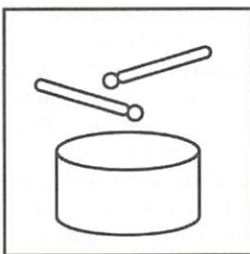
Read, sing or say a nursery rhyme. Add motions.



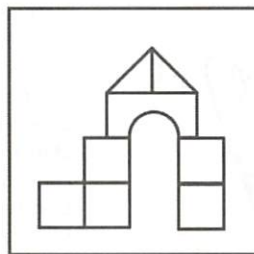
Find and name the shapes and colors you see around you.



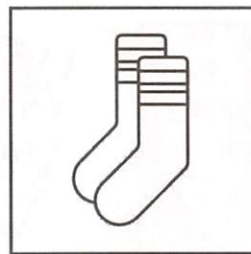
Point to and sound out the alphabet. Sing the alphabet song.



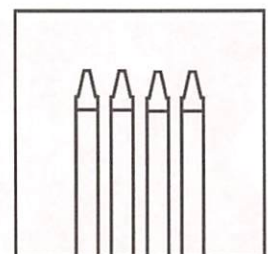
Sing and make music using pots, pans, or musical instruments.
